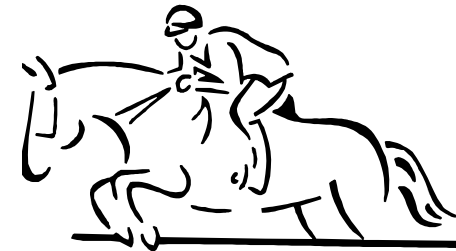

Leadline Division

Open to riders of any age who have never shown in walk/trot . Handlers must be 16 yrs or older

1. Leadline Equitation 2. Leadline Pleasure 3. Leadline Trail

Walk/Trot Division

Open to riders of any age who have never cantered at a horseshow

4. Walk/Trot Equitation 5. Walk/trot Pleasure 6. Walk/Trot Ground poles
7. Walk/Trot mini crossrails

Short Stirrup Division

Open to riders 12 and under – riders may only cross enter into the Beginner Hunter Division
Crossrails will be 18"

Open to riders 13 years of age and older- riders may only cross enter into Beginner Hunter

Notes, Rules, and Guidelines

- *Warning - Under Massachusetts Law - An equine professional is not liable for any injury to, or the death of, a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities, pursuant to Section 2D of chapter 128 of the general laws.*
- Admission to the show grounds is free
- Regular classes: \$10 per class. Stake and Medal Classes: \$15
- Pre-Entries PREFERRED. Payment need not accompany pre-entries.

Riders / trainers / guardians will still need to fill out and sign entry form day of show.
- Payments (to Three County Fair) must be made in full prior to horse leaving show grounds at conclusion of day.
- Proper Tack and attire required for all classes. ALL riders must wear approved helmets while mounted.
- Show management reserves the right to cancel, combine or split classes as entries warrant.
- Riders under the age of 18 may not show without written permission of parents or guardian.
- Manners and safety are of the utmost importance. Unruly horses shall be excused from either a class or the premises. The safety of other riders and spectators must be a priority.
- THE SHOW COMMITTEE REQUESTS THAT YOU LEAVE YOUR DOGS AT HOME
- Trophy and six ribbons for each class. Champions and reserves for divisions of 3 or more classes. Riders must ride and be judged in all 3 or more classes in division in order to be eligible for championships. Proof of negative coggins test is required. This will be checked upon entering grounds.
- All ages as of January 1, 2010. Juniors: 17/under. Adults: 18/over
- Judge's decisions are final. No one may approach the judge without permission.
