### INSTRUCTIONS & RULES

1. All goats must be free of contagious and infectious diseases. Any animal found to be developing symptoms of disease may be sent home by the Superintendent or the Fair. Health papers are required for in-state animals and must be signed by accredited veterinarian. Out-of-state animals must have health papers for TB and Brucellosis as well.
2. All animals must be owned by the exhibitor prior to 6/1/10
3. Each exhibitor is limited to 2 entries per class.
4. Goats shown in specialty classes must have been shown in single classes.
5. Only exhibitors and Fair employees are allowed to work on the goats at the Fairgrounds.
6. **RABIES SHOTS** are recommended.
7. **Bedding is NOT provided.**

### YOUTH GOAT FITTING & SHOWMANSHIP CONTEST DIVISION 334

Saturday, September 4, 2010 at 11:00 AM

All goat exhibitors must participate in Fitting & Showmanship. Failure to participate will result in forfeit of all goat prizes and monies.

Fitting and showmanship will be judged as separate classes

Fitting will start at 11 am. Exhibitors will be placed on fitting teams. Each time will fit a single goat readying it for the show ring in 90 minutes. Exhibitors should finish the fitting class by being prepared to step into a showmanship class. You will be judged on fitting and showmanship according to ADGA score card. Showmanship will immediately follow fitting class. You will use your own showmanship animal. Ribbons and prizes will be awarded

The following uniforms are to be worn when showing goats:

Girls - white blouses, khaki or white slacks, skirts or shorts

Boys - white or 4-H or FFA "Tee" shirts, khaki pants or shorts

### CLASS

01. Advance - For exhibitors over 14 years old who have previously won 1<sup>st</sup> place in a senior showmanship contest.
02. Senior - For exhibitors 14 through 19 years of age 1/1/09 who have shown animals previously.
03. Junior - For exhibitors 9 through 13 years of age 1/1/09 who have shown animals previously.

04. Novice - For all exhibitors who have not show their goat prior to this year.

Champion Showman will be judged from all the 1<sup>st</sup> place winners in classes 1, 2, 3, 4 in div 334

All exhibitors will be entered for the Herdsman Award. Judging will be based upon keeping the animals and general area neat, clean and attractive, and upon the attitude and cooperation of exhibitor. Displays and posters may be used in your herd areas to improve on education the general public about goats.

### DAIRY & MEAT GOAT DIVISIONS

Classes are open to all ADGA recognized breeds with a separate class for grades, pet and meat goats. Two animals of the same breed in any class will be considered a separate class.
