1. All swine must be free of contagious & infectious diseases.
2. All exhibitors must have owned animals to be shown before July 1, 2010 Feeding and care of the animals is the responsibility of the exhibitor, **Bedding will not be provided.**
3. No boars will be allowed.
4. Each exhibitor is limited to showing one animal in this contest. This animal must be shown in both the Showmanship and market hog classes. Failure to participate will result in forfeit of all swine prizes.
5. To be eligible for premiums, all animals must be shown in the ring by exhibitors and must respond to show-stick or cane.
6. The following uniforms are to be worn: White Shirts or Tee Shirts  
Gray, Khaki pants or Bermuda Shorts

Failure to wear the proper uniform will result in reduction of premium awards or disqualification.

### FITTING & SHOWMANSHIP DIVISION 368

- CLASS 01. Senior - For exhibitors 14 to 19 years of age who have shown swine previous to this year.
02. Junior - For exhibitors 9 to 13 years of age who have shown swine previous to this year.
03. Novice - For exhibitors who have not shown swine in any show previous to this year.

Champion Showman - The first place showman of the three Swine Showmanship Classes will compete for champion showman awards.
